- GENERAL INFORMATION -

1. **Entry Fee:** \$4.00 per bird.
2. **Entry Deadline:** By mail or telephone on or before Tuesday, November 13, 2017.
3. **For Sale Cages:** \$6.00 a hole
4. All Fees must accompany your entry.
5. **ATTENTION:** Make checks, money orders or vouchers payable to: **New York Combine.**
6. **NOTE: Non-Flown Show Racing Homer entry and fees:**

8. **NOTE:** Exhibitors with birds must enter through the front doors of the building to pick up their entry. Non-exhibitors must enter through the double doors at the front of the building and pay the \$10.00 non-exhibitor's fee.
9. **National Show Racing Pigeon Ass. Membership:** \$10.00. Please include a separate check or money order for your dues payable to: The National Show Racing Pigeon Assn.

- SHOW INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS-

1. The show is divided into Separate Divisions: Non-Flown Show Racing Homers, American Show Racers, and American German Beauty Homers. Awards will be given in all three divisions.
2. All birds must be banded with a seamless band of a recognized association.
3. A bird may not be entered in more than one class within its division. Such violations will be reason for the disqualification of the exhibitor's entire entry.
4. Entries will be accepted at the show hall Friday evening from 4:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M.
5. Doors open Saturday, the day of the show, at 8:30 A.M.
6. Judging starts Saturday, the day of the show, at 9:00 A.M.
EXCEPTION: The American Show Racers judging will start Friday evening at 5:00 PM sharp.
7. Minimal entry changes and/or additions will be accepted Saturday, the day of the show, until 9:00 A.M.
8. All exhibitors are responsible to steward their birds(s) to and from the judging area. Please, be prompt in doing so. If you need assistance or will not be in the area at that time notify the division's show coordinator to receive assistance.
9. All birds entered in class completion will be brought before a judge.
10. Upon inspection by the judge or president, The National Show Racing Pigeon Assn. reserves the right to remove any bird(s) from the show hall that is/are of questionable health. No refunds will be granted.
11. Every attempt will be made to keep materials and such secure and birds from escaping, being lost, injured or stolen. Overnight security is provided within the show hall.
12. We understand accidents can happen. Please double check to assure you have and are leaving the show with only your birds.

Non-Flown Show Racing Homers

The back bar system will be used. Any bird viewed as improperly entered by the judge or the show coordinator will be transferred to the proper class. If that class has already been judged the bird will be transferred to the appropriate "Open Class."

PLEASE NOTE: The Pied, Splash, Whiteflight class is for ALL BIRDS with one or more such markings regardless of the bird's overall primary color and/or pattern, this also includes all the A.O.C. Class colors. The only exception(s) will be if you deem to show your marked bird(s) in the Open Class or the S.H.O.W./S.R.H.A./ S.H.O.F. Club Band Class.

PLEASE NOTE: Birds with "TICK" markings are shown in their primary color class. Not the Pied, Whiteflight, Splash Class. The exception will be if you deem to show them in the Open Class or the S.H.O.W./S.R.H.A./ S.H.O.F. Club Band Class.

Hyatt Regency Greenwich

Take I-95, Connecticut Turnpike to Exit 5, US-1 North. Travel less than ½ mile and turn right onto E. Putnam Ave./US-1 N. Then travel about ¾ mile, the Hyatt Regency is on your right.
Or just plug in your GPS to: 1800 East Putnam Ave., Old Greenwich, CT

Eastern Greenwich Civic Center

Take I-95, Connecticut Turnpike to Exit 5. Make a right onto US-1 and go about ¼ mile and make a right onto South Beach Ave. Go about ½ mile and bear right at the traffic circle then make an immediate left onto Forest Ave. Continue ½ mile to the Civic Center.
From the Hyatt Regency go northeast on E. Putnam Ave./US-1 towards Havemeyer Ln. and turn right onto Laddins Rock Rd. go about ¾ mile and turn left onto Harding Rd. Continue about ½ mile to the Civic Center on your left.
Traveling south on the Connecticut Turnpike, I-95, take Exit 6, West Ave. and merge onto Grenhart Rd. Turn left at the 2nd traffic light onto Harvard Ave. go to the stop sign and turn right onto Selleck St. Go a short distance and bare left onto Brown House Rd. At the 4 way stop sign turn left onto Harding Rd. The Civic Center is on your left about 1 mile down the road. The parking lot is on the right across the street from the Civic Center also limited parking for exhibitors behind the Civic Center building.
Or just plug in your GPS to: 90 Harding Road, Old Greenwich, CT.
